RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, Prescriptions of the National Authority, IHCA Class Rules. Sailing Instructions will be available on-site.

ENTRIES

Open to all Hobie Classes. HCANA membership is required for crew or skipper. Proof of Liability Insurance is required.

SCORING

The low point scoring system in Rule A4 will be used. When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. One race shall be completed to constitute a regatta.

PENALTY SYSTEM: For all classes, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

VENUE

Races will be conducted in the waters of Harrison Lake directly in front of the town of Harrison. Rendall Park will be the launch location. Park access will be available from approximately 1200h, Friday August 30th to 1200h, Monday Sept 2nd. Boats may be left on-site until Monday morning.

FEES

\$50 for Single handed boats

\$70 for Double handed boats
